

THE CENTRO INTERDISCIPLINARE LINCEO GIOVANI (CILG)

Courtesy Translation

1. The *Centro Interdisciplinare Linceo Giovani* (CILG) is hereby established at the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei to foster scientific cooperation among young researchers and across different disciplines and fields of study.
2. In the activities of the Center, synergies should be fostered with the active research projects at the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and at the Centro Interdisciplinare Linceo "Beniamino Segre", ensuring a balanced distribution of projects across the various disciplinary areas.
3. Those who have been awarded the "Antonio Feltrinelli Young Scholar Award" may become members, subject to their acceptance of the invitation to join the Center and commitment to contributing to its operation.
4. The Center shall comprise of no more than sixty members, all of whom must be under the age of forty at the time of the invitation. Their member status within the Center shall be for a maximum duration of six years.
5. The invitation to join the Center rests with the Executive Board of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei, after consulting with the relevant Academy Classes for the Awards.
6. The Center shall appoint a Chairperson, a Deputy Chairperson, and an Executive Committee composed of four members. When the Chairperson is selected from among the awardees within the disciplines of the Class of Physical, Mathematical and Natural Sciences, the Deputy Chairperson must be selected from among the awardees within the disciplines of the Class of Moral, Historical and Philological Sciences, and vice versa.
7. The Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei, within the limits of its resources, provides the premises, equipment and services available for the Center's activities. The Accademia dei Lincei contributes to the activities of the Center providing an annual financial contribution in its ordinary budget. The allocation of the Center's resources is determined by the Assembly of its members, upon the proposal of the Executive Committee.
8. The Center is qualified to participate in international networks of young researchers/academics.
9. The structure and functions of the Center are defined in specific Regulations approved by the General Assembly of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei.

Transitional Provision

At the initial stages, the winners of the "Antonio Feltrinelli Young Scholar Award" for the years 2017-2018-2019-2020-2021-2022 may become members of the Center, forming the Founding Committee. They will be progressively joined by the prize winners of subsequent years until the total number of members reaches sixty. The awardees from 2017 to 2021 will serve for a term of six years from the date of the Center's establishment and shall lapse in order of seniority based on the year of their award, once the maximum number of members is reached.

REGULATIONS OF THE *CENTRO INTERDISCIPLINARE LINCEO GIOVANI (CILG)*

1. The *Centro Interdisciplinare Linceo Giovani (CILG)*, established within the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei, is composed of young scholars who have been awarded the “Antonio Feltrinelli Young Scholar Award” and have agreed to join, taking on the associated responsibilities, upon invitation from the Executive Board of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei, in accordance with the procedures outlined in the founding document of the Center.
2. The Center is formed by its members and aims to : a) promote scientific cooperation among young researchers from diverse disciplines and fields of study; b) contribute to the scientific and cultural activities of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and the Centro Interdisciplinare Linceo "Beniamino Segre"; c) represent Italy in international networks of young researchers/academics.
3. Further collaborations promoted by the Center, regulated by agreements and/or letters of intent, at no cost to the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei, may include participation in European, international, national, regional calls and funding relevant to the topics in Article 2.
4. All agreements, conventions or letters of intent are entered into by the governing bodies of the Academy in accordance with the current Statutes and Regulations.
5. The maximum number of members of the Center is sixty.
6. The activities of the Center are carried out effectively, including through remote means, according to the guidelines issued by the Assembly, or, in its absence, by the Executive Committee.
7. Members of the Center may, with the consent of the Executive Committee, form temporary working groups on specific topics, preferably maintaining the interdisciplinary nature of their composition.
8. The governing bodies of the Center are: the Assembly; the Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson; and the Executive Committee. At the beginning of each meeting, a secretary is appointed who will be responsible for drafting the minutes of the meeting and sending them to the Chairperson of the Center no later than seven days after the meeting, as well as to the President of the Academy, to the Executive Board of the Academy, and to each member of the Executive Committee.
9. The Assembly is composed of all active members. It meets, when convened by the Chairperson who presides over it, also in virtual format, at least twice a year to deliberate on the proposed allocation of the Center’s resources formulated by the Executive Committee, as well as on any other topic placed on the agenda by the Executive Committee, or proposed by at least five Members. In the first convocation, the Assembly is convened and chaired by the oldest Member.
10. The Assembly elects, by majority vote, the Chairperson and the Deputy Chairperson from among its members. When the Chairperson is selected from among the awardees within the disciplines of the Class of Physical, Mathematical and Natural Sciences, the Deputy Chairperson must be selected from among the awardees within the disciplines of the Class of Moral, Historical and Philological Sciences, and vice versa.

The Assembly elects two of its members from among the awardees within the disciplines of the Class of Physical, Mathematical and Natural Sciences and two of its members from among the awardees within the disciplines of the Class of Moral, Historical and Philological Sciences to compose the Executive Committee.

The Assembly approves the financial statement of the Center, prepared by the Chairperson, and the final and programmatic reports on the activities carried out and those to be carried out, to be submitted to the Executive Board of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei.

11. The Chairperson of the Center maintains relations with any third-party entity, promotes its activities with the assistance of the Deputy Chairperson for all matters not assigned by these Regulations to other bodies.

The Chairperson is replaced by the Deputy Chairperson in case of any impediment.

12. The Executive Committee meets once every two months, either virtually or in hybrid format, to plan and review all the activities carried out or to be carried out.
13. The Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and the members of the Executive Committee serve for a three-year term and are not eligible for re-election.

When a member of the Center leaves office prematurely for any reason, the Assembly, convened ad hoc, shall replace him or her by a majority of the vote, ensuring the proportional balance between members from among the awardees within the disciplines of the Class of Physical, Mathematical and Natural Sciences and members from among the awardees within the disciplines of the Class of Moral, Historical and Philological Sciences. The newly elected member's term ends on the same date as that of the member they are replacing.

14. Membership in the Center is acquired upon acceptance of the invitation from the Executive Board of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and ceases in the following cases: a) subject to the application of the transitional rule of the founding act, upon reaching the age of forty-six; b) resignation; c) failure to participate in all the activities of the Center for two consecutive academic years, as ascertained unanimously by the Executive Committee with the consent of the Executive Board of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei.
