INTERNATIONAL PRIZE “UGO PROCACCI” FOR 2027

COMPETITION NOTICE

Art. 1 (Nature of the Prize)

The Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei, in order to honour the memory of the Member of the Academy Prof. Ugo Procacci, shall announce a competition for a Prize of € 5.000 (*gross of applicable taxes*), to be awarded annually, for a study relevant to his scientific interests and his role in the conservation of the Italian artistic heritage. The Prize is reserved for theses already defended, either at the master's or doctoral level, based on extensive archival documentation, addressing topics in history or art history of the Middle Ages and the Renaissance, or topics in the history of restoration. The Prize shall be awarded with the aim of supporting the further advancement of the research.

Art. 2 (Eligibility)

Italian and foreign citizens who have already defended a master's or doctoral thesis on the subjects referred to in Article 1 may compete for the Prize, and, in consideration of the aforementioned purpose of the Prize, must submit, together with the thesis, a plan for preparing the text for publication. The back of the title page of the publication shall include a reference to the “Ugo Procacci” Prize.

Art. 3 (Terms and Conditions for Submission of Applications)

Applications must be submitted exclusively online, by completing the form available at <https://www.lincei.it/it/Bandi> **no later than 30 November 2026**.

Applications that are incomplete, irregular, or submitted using methods and/or within timeframes other than those set forth in this notice shall be deemed invalid.

No forms of submission or delivery of applications other than completing the above-mentioned online form shall be permitted.

Access to the procedure for completing the online application form shall be granted through the credentials issued during the registration process.

The application must be submitted **no later than 6 p.m. on 30 November 2026**.

Should the candidate complete the online form multiple times, only the last application submitted within the deadline shall be taken into consideration.

The date of submission of the application shall be certified by the electronic system. Upon expiry of the deadline, the system will no longer permit submission of applications but will only allow to view and print previously submitted applications.

In the application candidates must declare, under their own responsibility and pursuant to Presidential Decree of 28 December 2000, No. 445, as subsequently amended:

- 1a. Place of residence;
- 2a. The type of Master's Degree or Doctorate (PhD) obtained, indicating the University, the grade or evaluation awarded, and the date of the final examination;
- 3a. Full address, including postal code, telephone number, and email address, to which all communications relating to the competition should be sent, with a commitment to promptly notify any subsequent changes;
- 4a. Awareness of the criminal penalties provided for under Article 76 of Presidential Decree No. 445 of 28 December 2000, in cases of falsification of documents and false declarations.

Candidates must attach the following documents (*exclusively in PDF format*) to their application:

- 1b. A copy of an identity document.
- 2b. A copy of the master's or doctoral thesis. The master's or doctoral thesis must be attached in PDF format, respecting the file size limits allowed by the platform (15 MB); *

* Only in the event that the thesis exceeds the file size limits permitted by the system, a link to the thesis must be provided in a dedicated PDF file to be attached. The link, where the corresponding file (PDF format only) is to be uploaded, may be created using cloud service platforms (e.g., OneDrive, Google Drive, etc.) and must not include expiration limits or password protection (it is recommended to verify the link's accessibility in advance before attaching the PDF file containing it).

NOTE: If the link is inactive or inaccessible, the application will not be accepted.

- 3b. A plan for preparing the text for publication (*the back of the title page of the publication must include a reference to the "Ugo Procacci" Prize*). The plan must be attached in PDF format, respecting the file size limits allowed by the platform (30 MB); **

** Only in the event that the plan exceeds the file size limits permitted by the system, a link to the plan must be provided in a dedicated PDF file to be attached. The link, where the corresponding file (PDF format only) is to be uploaded, may be created using cloud service platforms (e.g., OneDrive, Google Drive, etc.) and must not include expiration limits or password protection (it is recommended to verify the link's accessibility in advance before attaching the PDF file containing it).

NOTE: If the link is inactive or inaccessible, the application will not be accepted.

- 4b. Curriculum *vitae et studiorum*, in European format, dated and signed by the candidate.
- 5b. A list of all submitted documents (*as referred to in points 1b, 2b, 3b and 4b*), dated and signed by the candidate.

Failure to submit the documents referred to in points 1b), 2b), 3b) and 4b) of this article shall constitute grounds for exclusion from the selection procedure.

To allow the attached files to open correctly, the candidate must save each file in PDF format using short names (*Example: 1b_Surname.pdf; 2b_Surname.pdf; etc.*).

Any exclusion from the selection shall be communicated to the parties concerned by means of a reasoned decision.

Art. 4 (Selection Committee)

The selection Committee for the Prize shall be composed of five members. Four members, of whom at least one shall be a foreign scholar, shall be appointed by the Presidential Council and selected from among scholars in fields related to the studies of Ugo Procacci. A representative appointed by the Procacci family shall serve as the fifth member of the Committee.

The Prize may not be awarded *ex aequo*.

In the event that none of the submitted works is deemed worthy, two Prizes may be awarded in the following year.

The recommendation of the Committee regarding the awarding of the Prize shall be submitted for approval to the Class of Moral, Historical and Philological Sciences and, subsequently, for final approval to the Joint Classes of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei.

The Committee may also propose not to award the Prize.

Should the Prize not be awarded, it shall automatically be re-advertised for the following year.

Art. 5 (Outcome)

The outcome of the competition shall be published on the official website of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei (www.lincei.it).

Art. 6 (Awarding)

The Prize shall be formally awarded during the Opening Ceremony of the Academic Year 2027-2028, in November 2027.

Art. 7 (Processing of Personal Data)

Personal data will be processed by the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei in accordance with applicable legislation, as described in the privacy notice available on the [Lincei website](http://www.lincei.it).
