INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA OF NATIONAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS INFORMATION

In accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter "Regulation"), we provide you with the necessary information regarding the processing of personal data provided by you.

DATA CONTROLLER

The Data Controller is the Accademia nazionale dei Lincei, located at Via della Lungara 10, 00165 Rome (e-mail: protocollo@lincei.it – PEC: accademianazionaledeilincei@postecert.it – telephone: 066868200), represented by the President, who is the legal representative of the Institution.

LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING

The personal data you provide will be processed by the Controller for the purposes of performing a public interest task, as well as fulfilling a legal obligation.

PURPOSES AND TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED

The processing of your personal data is aimed at managing institutional relationships between the Academy and the entity/organization represented by you.

For this reason, the following categories of personal data will be subject to processing:

- personal data.

In addition to the above purpose, the personal data relating to you may also be processed for the further purpose of archiving in the public interest, scientific or historical research, or for statistical purposes, which, in accordance with Article 89, paragraph 1, of the Regulation, is always considered compatible with the initial purposes.

METHODS OF PROCESSING

The personal data collected will be primarily processed using IT tools (e.g., applications for transmitting, recording, storing, and archiving data and documents or for implementing and managing databases), but also through non-automated methods and with similar tools, in both cases, in accordance with Article 32 of the GDPR regarding security measures, carried out by specially authorized subjects for the purposes indicated above.

DATA RETENTION

The personal data relating to you, contained in documents and/or databases produced, acquired and managed in relation to relevant institutional activities, will be subject to permanent retention, in accordance with the purposes of archiving in the public interest, scientific or historical research, or for statistical purposes.

In the event of occasional communications, your personal data will be deleted once the purposes of the processing have been fulfilled, as specified in the document retention plan adopted by the Institution.

COMMUNICATION AND DISSEMINATION OF DATA

Your personal data may be communicated to:

- Employees and members of the Academy;
- Other public authorities that process data in the performance of specific legal obligations (e.g., law enforcement agencies);
- Public and private entities, institutions, and foundations with which the Academy maintains institutional and scientific relationships;
- Data processors as defined in Article 28 of the Regulation, who process the data on behalf of the Controller and according to the instructions of the Controller.

The list of these Data Processors is available for consultation upon request.

TRANSFER OF DATA TO THIRD COUNTRIES OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

Your data may be transferred to third countries, even those not members of the European Union, in accordance with the institutional collaboration relationships maintained by the Controller with other foreign entities, organizations, or scientific academies, previa verification of measures aimed at ensuring an adequate level of protection, in accordance with Articles 45-46 of the Regulation.

RIGHTS EXERCISED

Data subjects have the right to obtain from the Controller, where applicable, access to their personal data and to have them rectified or erased, or to limit the processing of their data, or to object to the processing (Articles 15 and following of the Regulation). The appropriate request should be submitted by contacting the Data Protection Officer (Accademia nazionale dei Lincei - Data Protection Officer, Via della Lungara 10, 00165 Rome, email: rpdl@lincei.it).

Please note that for data processed for purposes of public interest archiving, scientific, or historical research, or for statistical purposes, derogations to the rights mentioned above are provided.

RIGHT TO COMPLAIN

If you believe that the processing of your personal data is taking place in violation of the Regulation, you have the right to lodge a complaint according to the procedure indicated in the data protection policy of this entity (<https://www.linkei.it/it/trasparenza/protezione-dati-personali>), or to contact the Data Protection Authority, as provided for in Article 77 of the Regulation, or finally, to pursue legal action (Article 79 of the Regulation).
